uring her nearly 30 years of volunteering for VLN, Laurel has contributed countless hours to family law clients while furnishing significant organizational support on our board and committees. She is making a big difference in the lives of people who cannot afford needed legal help.

When Laurel first applied to volunteer, she asked for the simple cases — no custody disputes — because her law firm was small and had limited resources. Initially, she helped out once or twice a month on the phone advice panel, which supports numerous family law clients. Since then, Laurel has expanded the scope of her services greatly. For years she has taken our most difficult and contentious cases, from complicated custody and paternity matters to problems involving child support and spousal maintenance.


In addition, Laurel mentors new volunteers. She counsels each individual, then sits in on client meetings, provides support at hearings, and does whatever it takes to help the newcomer provide quality representation to VLN clients.

It would be difficult to tally the monetary value of the hours and office expenses that Laurel has donated, but her impact on the lives of the families she has helped is immeasurable. For example, she took on a custody case that began five years ago, involving two trials and an appeal. In all, Laurel devoted more than 300 hours — and her client recently won! When the child was living with his father, he was acting out, cutting up furniture with a knife, and assaulting other children at school. The latter got him assigned to special education and even placement in a locked unit. Now, the aunt has custody, and the boy's behavior and school performance have improved dramatically.






Services Provided at Major Clinics

Ronald Blum Volunteer Attorney n May 22, 2011, a tornado wreaked havoc in North Minneapolis, destroying many homes in Arelia's neighborhood. Arelia's house was not spared. Her electrical box was down, her roof was damaged, and trees blocked both doors. Fortunately for Arelia, she had homeowner's insurance and

thought that the insurance would be there to cover the expense of putting her damaged home back together.

Arelia's insurance company was not there for her. Her insurance company finally stepped in, but then disappeared for two months. Arelia had been severely injured in an automobile accident. Her injury made it extremely difficult for her to talk. The insurance company denied coverage and made it difficult for Arelia to communicate with them.

Volunteer Lawyers Network held a clinic for people whose homes were damaged by the tornado in Arelia's neighborhood. Arelia turned to VLN for help. VLN connected Arelia to attorney Stephen Schemenauer.

Stephen was able to obtain insurance cover age for Arelia, but it was an uphill battle.

The insurance company had a very unfavorable depreciation assessment of Arelia's home. There were also two mechanics liens on her property. Mr. Schemenauer was able to resolve the two mechanics liens in conciliation court. Through this work, Mr. Schemenauer was able to get Arelia's home repaired with the insurance company covering the expense of the repair work.

Arelia feels that she was part of the legal team and that her back was covered.

Stephen indicates that "the legal system is not designed to be on your own. You really need an attorney. I like to volunteer with VLN because their support staff is very responsive...They put us in contact with very deserving people who have legitimate pro bono needs."






enny, a grandmother with an assault conviction nearly a decade old, came to VLN seeking a criminal expungment. Jenny was struggling to try to single-handedly support four children and a grandchild but was unable to use her degree by working at medical facilities due to a disqualification from the Department of Human Services. Volunteers through VLN put together a petition for Jenny and cleared her record with the court and executive record-holders including DHS. Just recently, we've received word that Jenny has now gained employment at a local healthcare facility.

548 Criminal Expungement services were provided via phone advice or at a criminal expungment workshop.





Josh is a regular participant in nearly every VLN expungement event—monthly seminars in and out of the Twin Cities, Second Chance Saturday weekend clinics, Project Homeless Connect, StandDown, and other community events. At this point, VLN rarely has to ask if Josh wishes to volunteer; we just give him the date and time.

In addition, shortly after beginning as a volunteer, and with little direct experience, Josh took on full representation of four

criminal expungement clients. One of those clients had a particularly difficult case, and relief would have been very unlikely if the client had pursued the matter alone. Josh successfully helped the client get his records sealed, allowing him to once again actively pursue steady employment.

Josh offers an exceptional level of dedication to serving criminal expungement clients, and ensuring that those individuals who have worked hard to rehabilitate themselves receive a second chance to lead productive and successful lives. "I became a lawyer because I wanted to help people, and in our society it's often those who have the least that need help the most... if indigent expungement petitioners can't find probono help, they are usually left to fend for themselves." Criminal expungement is in high demand at VLN. Helping those clients takes outstanding volunteers like Josh.




