Claiming CLE Credit for Pro Bono Work

Among myriad other benefits of providing pro bono service, attorneys can claim up to six CLE credits per reporting period for their work with Volunteer Lawyers Network or <u>other approved providers</u>. Six hours of volunteering count for one CLE credit, so to claim the maximum number of credits, you must volunteer at least 36 qualifying hours per three-year reporting period.

Credit can be claimed by completing and mailing <u>Appendix II: Affidavit of Pro Bono</u> <u>Representation to the Minnesota State Board of Continuing Legal Education</u>, which is also included with this tip. It is a fillable PDF, which can also be printed and filled out by hand.

Complete separate affidavits for each legal service provider through which you provided services. If representation of a client spans more than one reporting period, file separate affidavits for each period, and write "ongoing" as the date representation ended.

When the form is complete, submit a print copy to the address at the top or email it to <u>clestaff@mbcle.state.mn.us</u>. When the credits are added to your record, you will receive a confirmation email from the Minnesota State Board of Continuing Legal Education.
