#### The Roadmap for the Journey Ahead

Looking back on 2022, I am incredibly proud of the work and accomplishments of VLN's volunteers and staff. Despite the ongoing global pandemic, helping community members in need remained the watchword for our volunteers, board, and staff. Through all the ups and downs of the past year, VLN remained a critical resource for our clients and communities navigating the tail-end of an unprecedented global health emergency.

One of the accomplishments I take the most pride in is the adoption of our 2022-2025 strategic plan. This plan is the result of over six months of hard work by our board and staff. From the beginning of the planning process, we decided it was critical to obtain feedback from our stakeholders. To that end, we conducted interviews with justice and community partners; surveyed staff members, board members, and volunteers; held a joint board and staff retreat; and had what seemed like countless discussions. In the end, we developed a plan that focuses on the pillars of VLN, our clients, our volunteers and community partners, and our staff.

The plan centers around three strategic commitments:

1) Create deeper community connections and build effective client-centered services; 2) Engage, train and support a culturally competent pool of energized volunteers; and 3) Invest in staff and infrastructure to foster a supportive and productive work environment.

We believe the strategic plan will allow VLN to adapt to a changing legal and pro bono landscape and ensure the organization is a resource for our clients and communities for years to come.

Developing the plan was only the beginning. Over the next three years, we will actively engage our volunteers, board, justice partners, and community partners as we work to implement our vision.

Now that we have a roadmap, it is time to begin our journey. I look forward to going on that journey with you.



#### In-Person Clinic Reopenings

VLN's in-person legal clinics are crucial in meeting our goal to provide client-centered services. Our in-person clinics allow volunteers and staff to meet clients where they are, facilitate more robust relationships between volunteers and their clients, and provide opportunities for clients to receive higher levels of service – especially with non-English-speaking clients.

We have begun reopening many of our in-person clinics that were closed due to the COVID-19 pandemic. In FY21-22, we reopened our Family Law Clinic at the Hennepin County Family Justice Center, the Second Chance Saturday criminal expungement clinic, and the Park Avenue Legal Clinic which celebrated 25 years of operation in 2022.

In addition to reopening existing programs, VLN expanded our clinic offerings to meet community needs. In spring 2022, we launched a new clinic at Mercado Central in South Minneapolis in partnership with Unidos Minnesota to serve the Spanish-speaking immigrant community.



#### VLN Volunteers go the Extra Mile

Despite the ongoing pandemic, more than 500 legal professional volunteers provided 5,941 services to our clients last year. VLN honored two of these extraordinary volunteers during our annual Riverfront Celebration on September 8, 2022.

lawyer, Susan worked in Intensive Care Unit management, the Emergency Department, and as a helicopter rescue nurse.

Susan earned her Juris Doctor in 1993 from William Mitchell College of Law. As a Rule 114 Qualified Neutral, Susan works as a mediator, arbitrator, early neutral evaluator, parenting consultant, custody evaluator, and special master. Susan is recognized as a Super Lawyer® and American Bar Association Fellow. Susan obtained certification as a Child and Family Forensic Evaluator through William James College in 2020.

Susan serves on the Minnesota Women Lawyer's Advisory Board and is an emeritus member of the Minnesota Association for Justice Board of Governors and the Executive Board of Minnesota Association of Family and Conciliation Courts. Susan is a Master of the Bench and President-Elect in the Warren E. Burger American Inn of Court.

Susan has been a volunteer attorney for Volunteer Lawyers Network since 2003 and past Chair of the VLN Family Law Committee. We are very grateful for Susan's dedication and skillful contributions to our community.

While facing serious health issues, creditors came after Barbara\*. "I couldn't keep up with all the bills with my health... I came across VLN and at first thought it was too good to be true that someone would help me for free."

Barbara's volunteer attorney not only helped her file for bankruptcy but went above and beyond to get her student loans forgiven as well. "[VLN staff and my attorney] very

understanding. They were so patient, so kind, and so helpful."



When Rosa\* found little success in securing legal help, VLN was there to assist her.

"There are a lot of people like me who don't have the financial resources to pay for an attorney."

"VLN allowed me to move forward, helping me in a case that I had for a long time. [My attorney] especially helped me a lot."

#### You Gave to the Max!

Thanks to all who donated during our Give to the Max campaign, VLN raised a record \$24,836, including a generous \$12,000 match from VLN's Board of Directors. Your gift allows us to provide free legal aid for clients like Mary\* (name changed). When Mary began searching for stable work, her record was an obstruction. "I started the process with VLN to get my record expunged, so I didn't have to explain the worst night of my life to a stranger," she explains. "[My volunteer lawyer] really took the time to understand what qualified for expungement... [She was] really respectful and careful in talking about it." With this assistance, Mary was able to expunge her records and secure employment. "I've been able to go into a job application with confidence, and not have to deal with the trauma of explaining my past."





When seeking to obtain custody of her child, Volunteer Lawyers Network was there to help Cassie\*.

"[VLN's volunteers] are excellent lawyers. They helped me in my case. They helped me out a lot to gain my son's custody."

Cassie's lawyer helped her understand the court process, how to speak to the judge, and how to win her case.

"Yes, I'm very grateful. I'm so grateful for the help."


